Warm greetings from Nagpur, India! Hope all is well with you and your family.
On behalf of DREAM Trust, I would like to wish you a happy and prosperous New Year!

I would like to thank you for sponsoring **Asha (nee Rekha) Ghule-Jadhav, Sandhya Ghule-Betole, Mamta Mohane and Rahul Bahade**, the Type 1 diabetic patients. Your generous support has certainly helped them a lot. The support takes care of their regular monitoring, insulin + syringes, healthcare and travel.

Asha's blood glucose levels are fairly good and her insulin requirement is less. She takes insulin twice a day – a total of 12 units! She has had a 3 kg weight loss since August 2003 but then she has been busy – has got a part time job with a local office – and of course the trauma of having lost her husband at a young age is affecting her. We have been counseling her to look after herself and not neglect her health. She also has to take care of her daughter.

Sandhya is doing well she takes insulin 2 times a day. She has shown a steady growth ever since she has registered with DREAM Trust. She weighs 41 kg now. Both she and her husband have to work hard to run the family and bring up their daughter who is 5 years old now. Please find enclosed herewith her recent photograph and the drawing she has made for you.

Mamta is doing well too. She has gained 3 kg since her registration with DREAM Trust over 4 months; she is 17 kg now. She goes to school – kindergarten. They have been given a blood glucose-monitoring meter and her parents have been able to monitor her blood glucose levels regularly. Please find enclosed herewith her recent photograph and the drawing she has made for you.

Rahul is doing well, takes insulin twice a day. He weighed 11 kg (year 2003) and 103 cm tall, now 18 kg and 108 cm (November 2004)

We learnt from Anna of your proposed visit to India and we look forward to meet you.

Anna Uhlich has been a great friend of DREAM Trust. Her enthusiastic and energetic self is a driving force for us. She has been coordinating the numerous sponsors from Austria, Switzerland, Germany and France; from her visits to Nagpur, India, she is the vital link between the children of DREAM Trust and the sponsors.
